Transport White Paper 2001 declares:

"Users should be placed at the heart of transport policy"....so that.... "everyone enjoys a transportation system that meets their needs and expectations."



The 2001 White Paper went on to say:

"In return for the increasingly high cost of mobility, (users) are entitled to expect a high quality service and full respect for their rights."



The 2001 Transport Action Programme proposed:

Extension of Air passengers' rights to Rail, Maritime, Urban transport, (+ Bus and coach?)



Foresees legislation to cover:

Service quality indicators, Service delivery, Needs of Persons with Reduced Mobility, Contract conditions, Transparent passenger information, Extra-judicial dispute settlement mechanisms


