


Railteam Network Map

Eurostar Meeting 5 December 2012





- General Comments Eurostar
 - Olympics and Paralympics (modified for wheelchairs)
 - PRM officer
 - Today two wheelchairs per train (new trains four)
 - New trails: Swiss Alps (winter) and Provence (summer)
- Passenger Issues:
 - UK border control and impact on passengers
 - Eurostar and TGV, Eurostar independent operator BE and FR
 - Ease of connection / onwards travel Lille, Brussels, Paris

Eurostar Meeting 5 December 2012





- Expanding the UK Mainland Europe rail Market
 - Stopping Ashford, Ebbsfleet and Stratford
 - regularly re-evaluate
 - Extension beyond Brussels and Paris (security issues)
 - niche markets French Alps (winter), Avignon (summer)
 - Amsterdam, Cologne and Frankfurt (waiting new trains)
 - Operator co-ordination with other high-speed operators
 - Through fare / booking
- Contingency plan snow timetable
- Different choice of destinations depending on country

Thalys Meeting 7 May 2012





- Train cancellations: 24 i.e. 26, one on fire (repair), one for upgrade
- Delays: after 20 years refurbishment for the next 20 years
- Coordination Thalys ICE on Brussels Köln, not every 2 hours
- Thalys Eurostar correspondences, schedule change December 2012
- Ticket price
 - Price increase from 12 March, now only flex, non-flex, semi-flex
 - Infra costs, Energy costs, Renovation and ERMTS
 - 300 tickets a Day for 22 Euro
 - Request for 2nd class full flex tickets?
 - Request for family tariffs







- Ticket price
 - "Castes" between same-price customers
 - iD TGV: 30 destinations pre-booking on-line for 19 Euro (2nd)
 - Board decides about price increase
 - Interail supplement
- Thalys Deutsche Bahn situation, DB left Thalys
- Punctuality and Communication
 - Huge delays 15 March, security is key
 - High amount of infra problems, specially in NL
 - External reasons and delays from DB





Service

- PRMs sometimes difficult, ICE lower tariff and free companion
- Cleanliness, on train cleaning between Brussels and Liège
- Interoperability DB Thalys tickets, now more difficult
- GSM noise, no silent cars
- Access to Public Transport in Aachen and Köln
- Quality criteria document for EU Commission to EPF?
- Bikes not anymore provided because of possible delays
- Future projects: refurbishment, fluidity, intermodality, information, no new destination, no trains to Airport Brussels, 2nd Essen?





- Report of Ian McDonald on "Proposed EuroCity services":
 - Goal is to improve existing services
 - Make some of them more frequent
 - Current failure to provide regular "cadence" frequencies
 - Extend or join up existing services across frontiers
 - Make them more worthwhile
 - Attract more customers
 - Competing with airlines or roads
- Documents available, Albert and Pierre analyse and decide to go on












- What: Country-specific important information on Public Transport for visitors

- The problems occur when you travel with several operators for sure with cross border trips




The awards aim to:
