- 12/2014 Suspension of EuroCity "Wawel" Berlin Wroclaw
- 03/2015 Suspension of "Dresden Wroclaw Express"
- 09/2015 Suspension of InterRegioEkspres
  Frankfurt (Oder) Poznan






#### What do we want – goals

• Better accessibility of metropoles and regional centres within the German-Polish border area

 Re-establishment of suspended connections (esp. Berlin – Wroclaw, Dresden – Wroclaw)

## What do we want – goals

- Better framework conditions for cross-border rail, e.g.
  - Financial solutions for long-distance rail transport
  - Reducing rail's discrimination concerning charges for the utilisation of infrastructure (compared to road traffic)
- Infrastructure modernisation (electrification, second tracks)



# Some promising improvements...

- Re-establishment of recently suspended connections:
  - Dresden Wroclaw: 12/2015
  - Berlin Wroclaw: special trains to the European Capital of Culture Wroclaw, on weekends, 04-09(?)/2016



## Some promising improvements...

- New regional connections:
  - Görlitz Jelenia Góra: 12/2015
  - Berlin Gorzów Wlkp. Krzyz: 03/2016
  - Berlin Frankfurt (O.) Zielona Góra: 04/2016





## **Outlook for 2016**

- Participation in the consultations on the German Federal Transport Plan (April/ May 2016)
- Lobbying activities concerning the next German-Polish Summit on Rail (autumn?)
