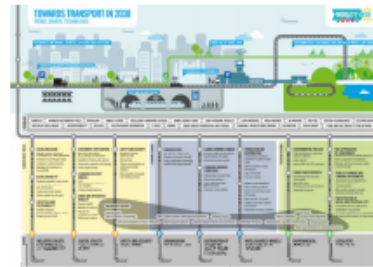
- Identify and assess **societal trends and challenges** that will influence future transport demand and supply

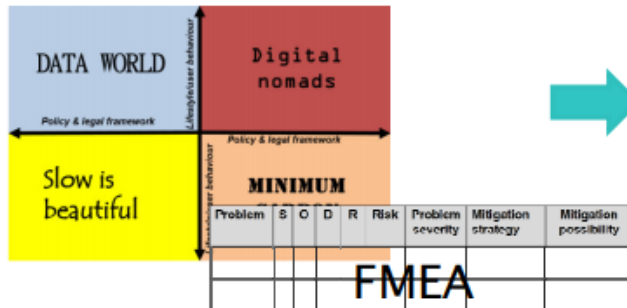
Pool of solutions Opportunity Map

The *European Transport and Mobility Forum* will be *an alliance* that helps identifying, designing and implementing novel ideas and innovation in synergetic ways and in participatory processes. The Forum will aim at:

- Establishing cross-modal links between different transport modes for passengers and freight;
- Integrating user perspectives into the network and into all transport aspects;
- Involving stakeholders beyond transport

Creating a “*human centered transport*” requires *bringing together all relevant takeholders* of passengers and freight transport, of the smart systems industry and of other fields (as e.g. energy, data, and services). Through the participatory framework involving all relevant actors, the Forum helps collaboration on cross-modal and user-centered transport, learning to address common challenges forward future mobility concepts, following up the Action Plan developed within the project.
